A cash budget is simply a listing of the firm's anticipated cash inflows and outflows over a specified period. Unlike a pro forma income statement (discussed in Chapter 5), the cash budget includes only actual cash flows. For example, depreciation expense (a noncash expense) does not appear on the cash budget, but principal payments on debt ...
