To get the water out from the very bottom of your washer, disconnect the drain hose from the wall. Position the drain hose as low as possible and into a floor drain if possible to empty the water. Note: Your washer may contain from 5 to 10 gallons of water.

When the washing machine is washing, the drain pump motor spins counterclockwise and allows the water to recirculate into the machine. When it's time to drain, the water fills the drain pump, and the motor reverses direction to force the water into the drain hose.

At the beginning of the method, you have to, first of all, remove off the front panel screws. You have to start by unplugging the machine and emptying the water.
