Section 111 of the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Extension Act of 2007 (MMSEA) added mandatory reporting requirements with respect to Medicare beneficiaries who have coverage under group health plan (GHP) arrangements as well as for Medicare beneficiaries who receive settlements, judgments, awards or other payment from liability insurance (including self-insurance), no-fault insurance, or workers' compensation, collectively referred to as Non-Group

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Health Plan (NGHP) or NGHP insurance.

Registration, Account Setup, and Training. Section 111 RREs are required to register with the COBC, set up an account, identify authorized users (Authorized Representative, Account Manager, and Account Designee (optional)) and satisfactorily test the data exchange process before submitting production files.

Last week the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued version 4.3 of its MMSEA Section 111 NGHP User Guide which can be accessed through this link . These changes were primarily driven by Congressional enactment of PAMA on April 1, 2014 which prohibits CMS from using ICD-10 codes on or before October 1, 2015.
